"Bone Chemistry and Ancient Diet in Ancient Italy and the Mediterranean"

Dr. Robert Tykot, Professor of Anthropology at the University of South Florida, will present on the use of isotopic and elemental methods of analysis to address diet in Italy and the ancient Mediterranean. He was one of the earliest to conduct carbon, nitrogen and oxygen isotope analyses in Italy on human skeletal remains, and will discuss the research he has done over three decades on the importance of fish, plant and animal domesticates, and secondary products in diet from the Neolithic thru Medieval times.
